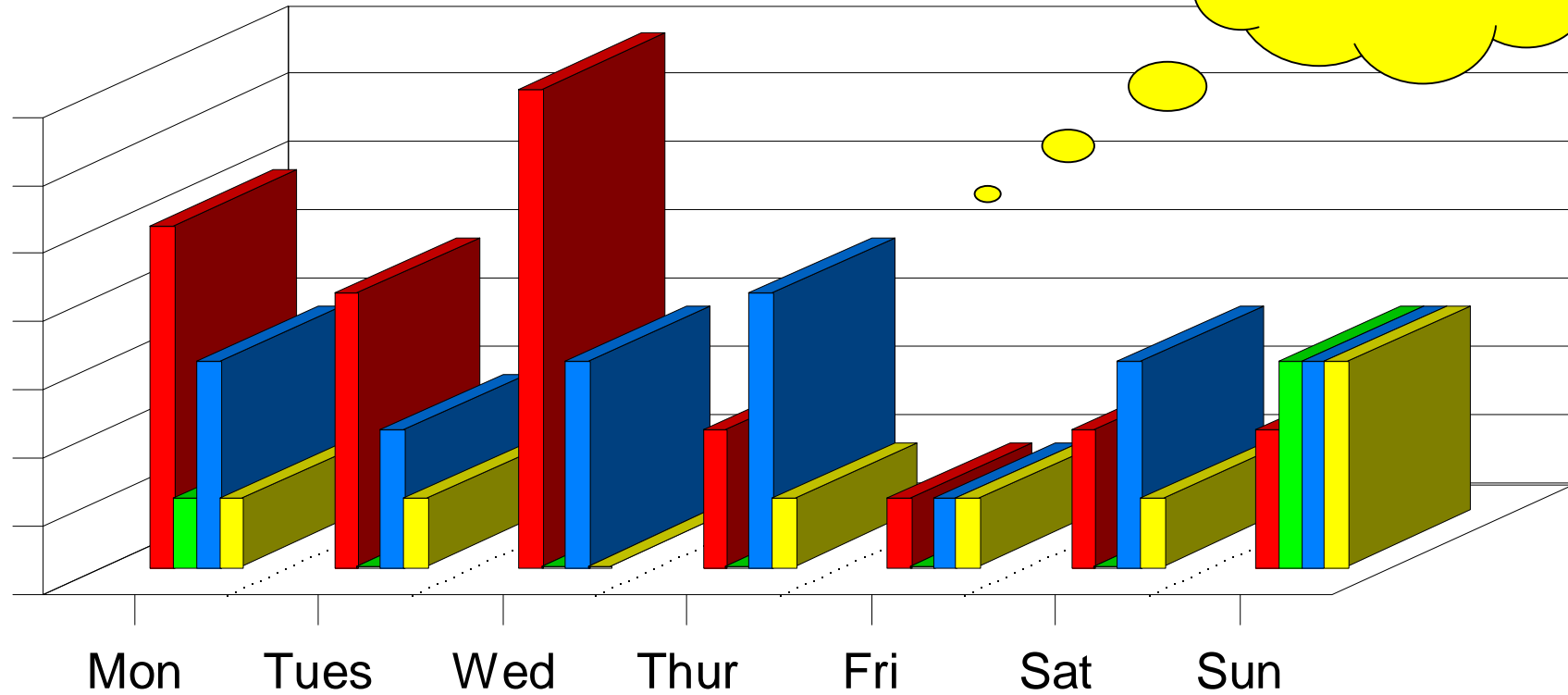

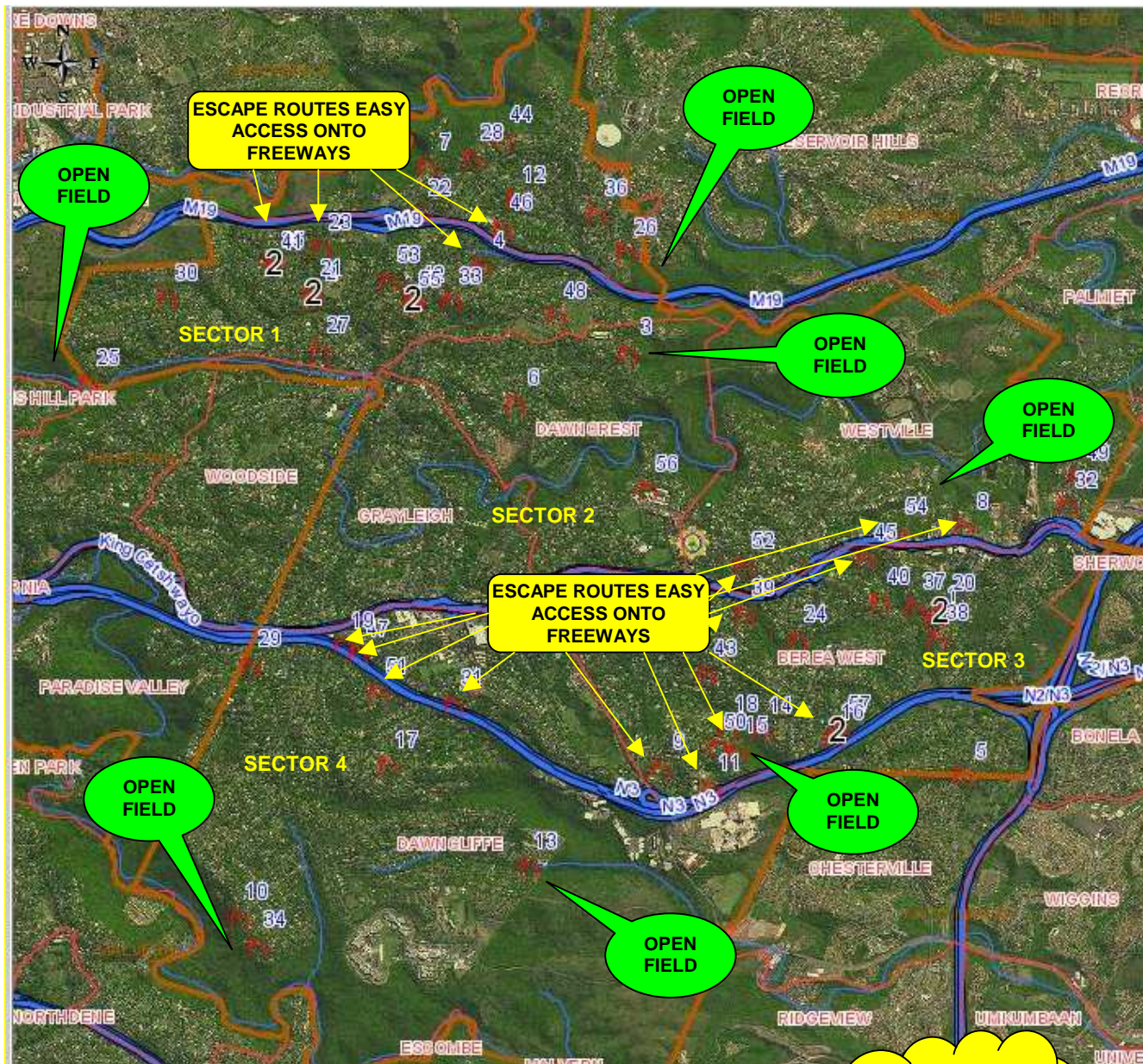

PROBLEM SECTOR

- SECTOR 1 (WESTVILLE NORTH) AND SECTOR 3 (BEREA WEST)

ENTRANCE GAINED

- 30% OF CASES ENTRANCE WAS GAINED BY FORCING OPEN THE WINDOW AND BURGLAR GUARDS
- 60% OF CASES ENTRANCE WAS GAINED BY FORCING OPEN DOOR
- 10% OF CASES ENTRANCE WAS GAINED BY REMOVING ROOF TILES

THERE HAS BEEN A INCREASE OF 44% IN BURGLARIES RESIDENTIAL FOR THE PERIOD MARCH 2010 COMPARED TO FEBRUARY 2010

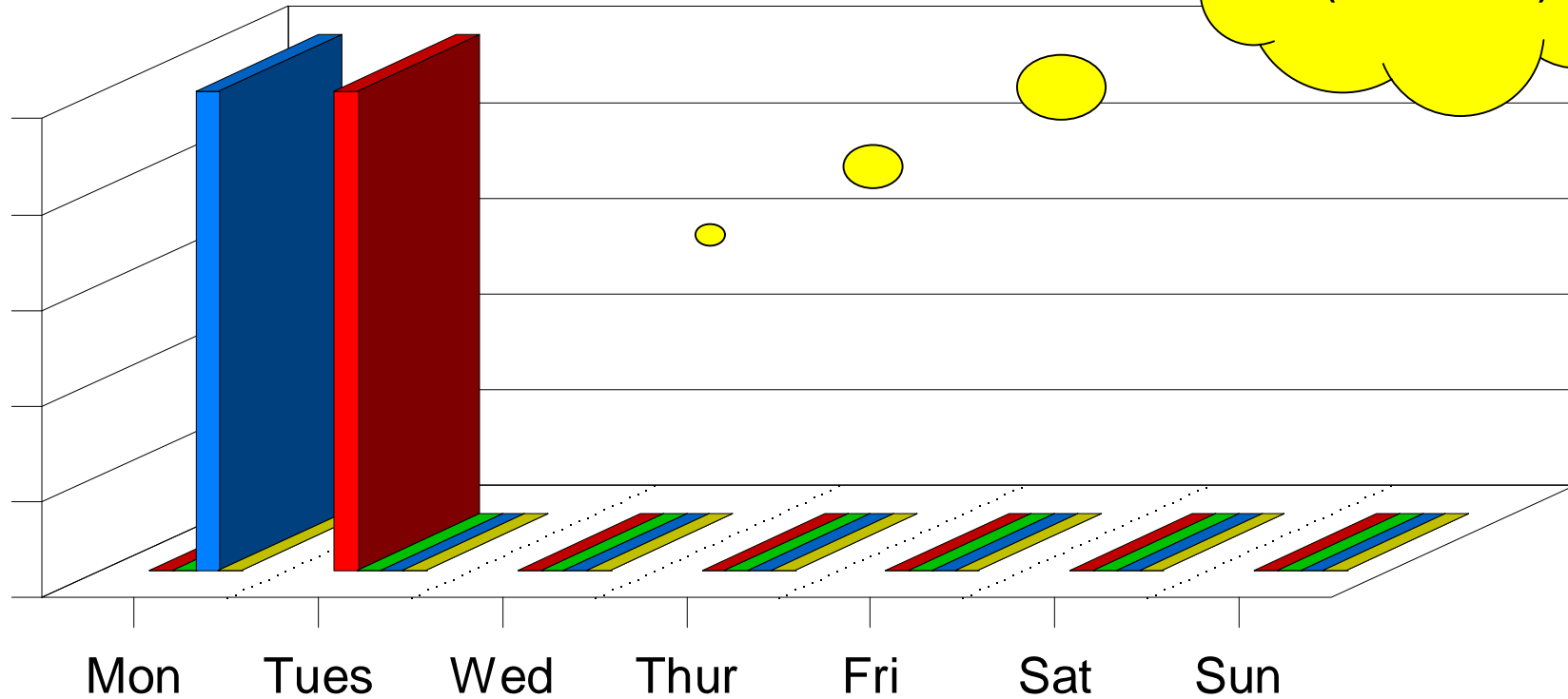
ARRESTS : THREE (3) ARRESTS

HOUSEBREAKING HINTS

- TEST YOUR ALARM ON A REGULAR BASIS, ENSURE YOU ALARM IS ACTIVATED AT ALL TIMES
- DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES WHERE THEY CAN BE SEEN BY CRIMINALS
- DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES IN YOUR GARAGE OR VISIBLE IN MOTOR VEHICLES
- IMPROVE THE LIGHTING AROUND YOUR PROPERTY
- CUT DOWN LUSH VEGETATION ADJACENT TO YOUR HOUSE
- BEFORE LEAVING TO GO ON HOLIDAY, INFORM YOUR NEIGHBOUR THAT YOU WILL NOT BE A HOME FOR A CERTAIN PERIOD
- ENSURE ALL TOOLS AND GARDEN EQUIPMENT IS LOCKED SAFELY AWAY
- WHEN GOING ON HOLIDAY ARRANGE FOR SOMEONE TO COLLECT YOUR POST FROM YOUR POST BOX ON A DAILY BASIS
- WHERE POSSIBLE ARRANGE FOR A RELIABLE HOUSE SITTER
- WHEN HAVING FUNCTIONS AT YOUR HOME, ARRANGE FOR CAR GUARDS
- REPORT ANY SUSPICIOUS PERSONS LOITERING IN YOUR ROAD
- WRITE DOWN SERIAL NUMBERS OF YOUR PROPERTY
- REPORT CRIME IMMEDIATELY

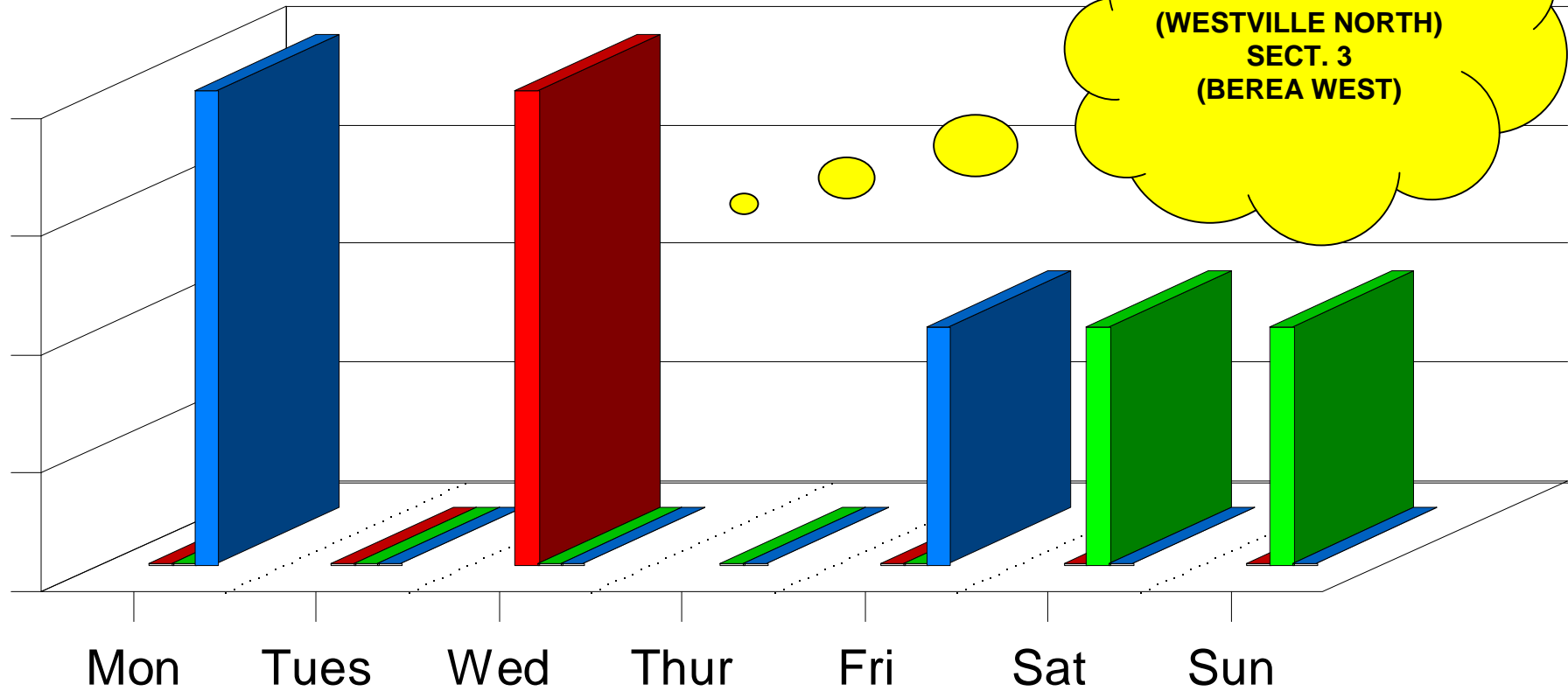



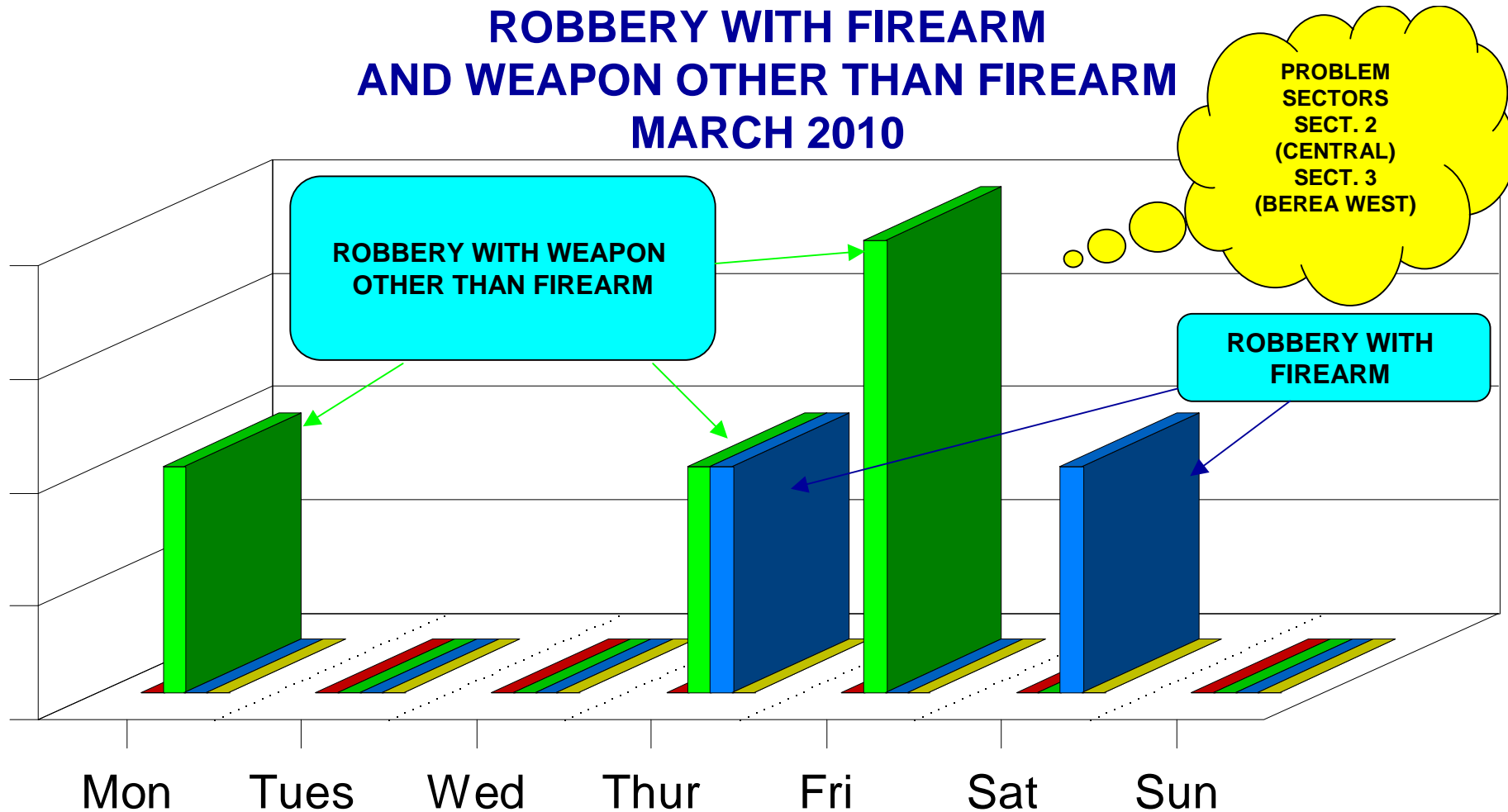

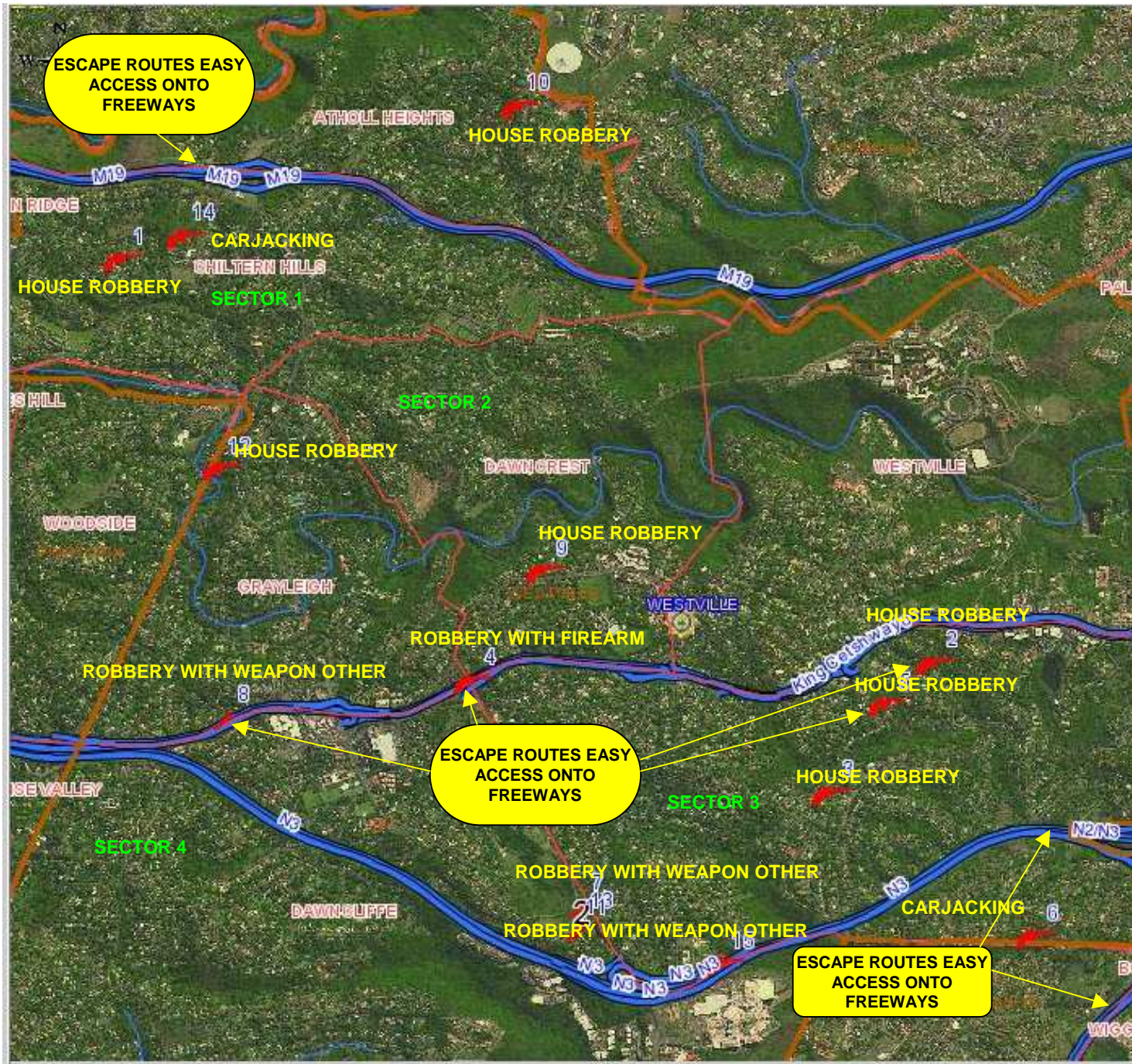


ARMED ROBBERY HINTS

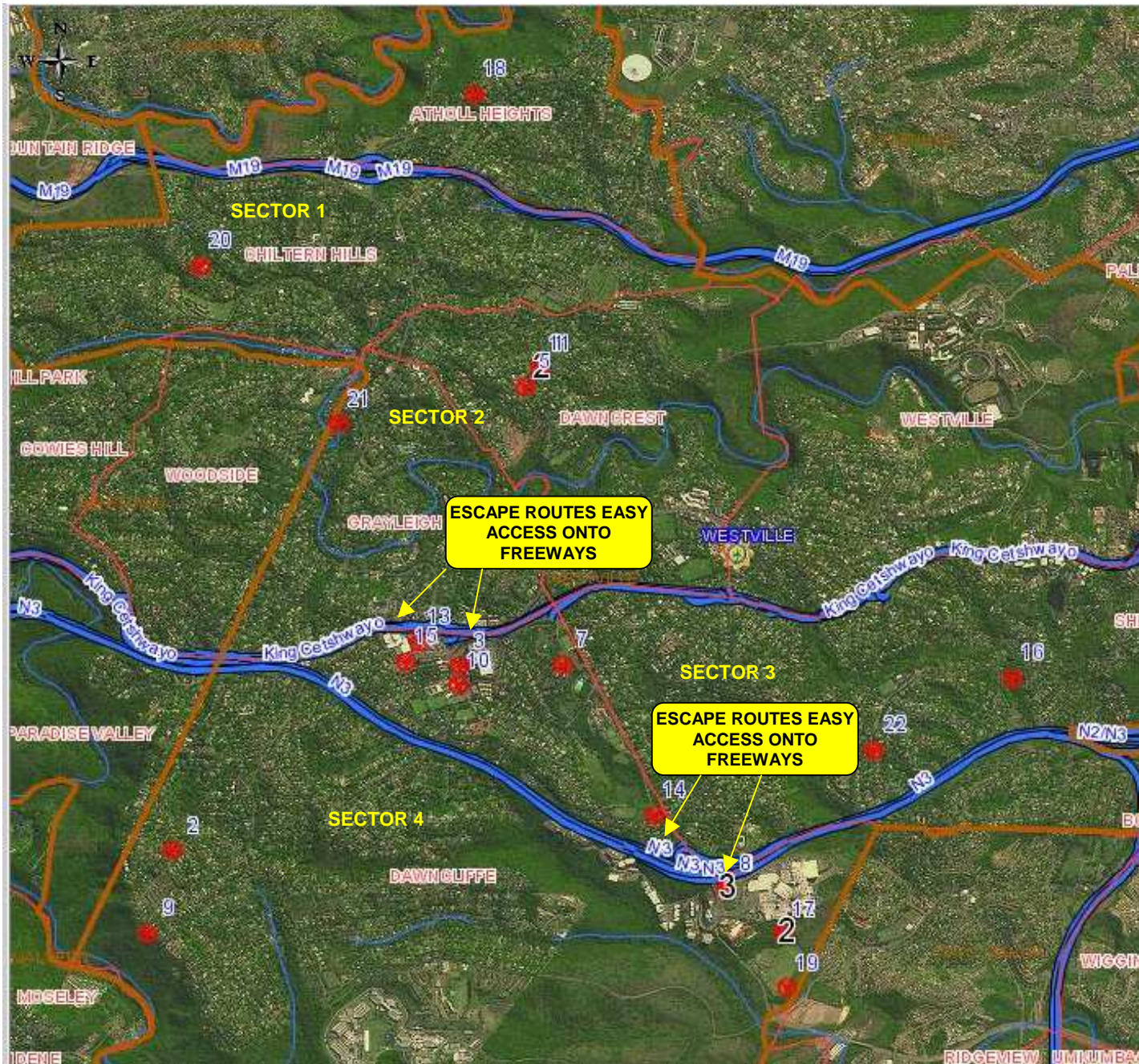
- BE AWARE OF SUSPICIOUS PERSONS LOITERING IN THE ROAD
- NEVER DRIVE STRAIGHT HOME IF YOU THINK YOU ARE BEING FOLLOWED
DRIVE TO THE NEAREST POLICE STATION
- KEEP YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE DOORS LOCKED WHILST TRAVELLING
- DO NOT OPEN DOORS TO STRANGERS WHEN AT HOME
- TRY TO AVOID DRIVING THE SAME ROUTE AND TIME TO AND FROM HOME
EVERY DAY
- BE PARTICULARLY AWARE WHEN CARRYING MONEY TO AND FROM BANKS
- INFORM DOMESTIC WORKERS NOT TO OPEN DOORS / GATES WITHOUT PRIOR
AUTHORISATION FROM YOU.
- ALWAYS ENSURE THAT YOUR CONTACT DETAILS AND EMERGENCY NUMBERS
ARE AVAILABLE FOR YOUR DOMESTIC WORKER / CHILDREN
- DOMESTIC WORKERS / CHILDREN TO HAVE DOORS LOCKED WHEN AT HOME
- TAKE CAUTION WHILST PARKED IN YOUR DRIVEWAY WAITING FOR YOUR
GATES TO OPEN / CLOSE, IF ALONE ARRANGE FOR SOME ONE TO MEET YOU
AT YOUR GATES
- AVOID STOPPING ON THE SIDE OF THE ROAD / FREEWAY

THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

MARCH 2010

PROBLEM SECTOR

- **SECTOR 2 AND SECTOR 4**

LOCATION WHERE VEHICLES WERE STOLEN FROM

- **40% OF CASES VEHICLES WERE STOLEN FROM THE YARD**
- **60% OF CASES VEHICLES WERE STOLEN FROM PARKING LOTS**

THERE HAS BEEN AN INCREASE OF 38% IN THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE PERIOD MARCH 2010 COMPARED TO FEBRUARY 2010.

THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE HINTS

- **ALWAYS LOCK YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE**
- **ACTIVATE MOTOR VEHICLE IMMOBILIZER/ALARM**
- **MAKE SURE GEARLOCK AND STEERING LOCKS ARE IN PLACE**
- **TEST YOUR TRACKING SYSTEM**
- **DO NOT PARK YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE ON THE SIDE OF THE ROAD**
- **MAKE SURE WHEN PARKING AT A SHOPPING CENTRE THAT YOU KNOW WHERE THE CAR GUARDS ARE**
- **ALWAYS PARK YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE AS CLOSE TO OTHER MOTOR VEHICLES AS POSSIBLE**
- **ALWAYS MAKE SURE THAT WHEN PARKING YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE AT NIGHT IT IS PARKED WHERE THERE IS SUFFICIENT LIGHTING**
- **AVOID LEAVING VALUABLES INSIDE OF YOUR MOTOR VEHICLE IN VIEW OF PERPETRATORS**
